The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent nos.4 to 5.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 09.07.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“As part of the enquiry, the above named were contacted telephonically Ranjit Singh (Father of Petitioner No. 1) by the ASI Malkeet Singh 589/Sgr Police Station Sadar Sangrur. Ranjit Singh above stated that the marriage of the petitioners had taken place with mutual consent and conveyed that he and his family members have not objection to the said marriage. He further assured that he and his

family members are no interference or hostility from their side, and that the petitioners are under no threat from he and his family members.”

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
