RUPINDERJIT CHAHAL, J (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No. 194 dated 06.10.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506 IPC (Sections 341, 34 and 201 IPC added later on and Section 325 IPC deleted later) at Police Station Amargarh, Malerkotla (Annexure P-1), and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 11.07.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 06.08.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected



between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 194 dated 06.10.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506 IPC (Sections 341, 34 and 201 IPC added later on and Section 325 IPC deleted later) at Police Station Amargarh, Malerkotla (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 30.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand(s) disposed of, accordingly.
