The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondents to grant the benefit of First & Second Assured Career Progression Scale to the petitioner with all the consequential benefits arising therefrom from the date the petitioner has completed 10 years and 20 years service in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in CWP-15840-2015.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 03.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar is directed to consider and decide the



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representation dated 03.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) in light of the judgment/order dated **03.07.2025** passed in **CWP-17809-2025** titled as ***“Jagdish Chander and others versus State of Haryana and others”*** submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.D. Sharma, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. He, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to the respondents to treat this writ petition as a representation and to take a considered decision in light of the judgment/order dated **03.07.2025** passed in **CWP-17809-2025** titled as ***“Jagdish Chander and others versus State of Haryana and others”***, within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that in the event the petitioners are found eligible for the benefits as claimed in the light of the judgment passed by this Court, the necessary benefits shall be released to him within a further period of two months.
