1. Applicant-petitioner has filed CRM-25932 of 2025 for withdrawal of petition under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.71 dated 04.11.2023 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Sector 17, Women Cell, Chandigarh, and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between petitioner and respondent No.2 vide compromise deed dated 03.07.2025, which has been produced in Court and is taken on record. He further submits that in view of the said

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compromise the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a petition seeking quashing of the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise.

- 4. Mr. Manish Bansal, Public Prosecutor, U.T., Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. P.S. Ahluwalia, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and they have no objection to the prayer made in the application.
- 5. For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed. Date of hearing of the main case is preponed from 08.09.2025 and the same is taken on board today itself.
- 6. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
