By way of present appeal, challenge has been laid to the judgment and decree dated 31.03.2010 passed by the Court of District Judge, Sangrur (**hereinafter to be referred as “First Appellate Court”**), whereby an appeal filed against the judgment and decree dated 05.12.2003 passed by the Court of Civil Judge (Junior Division), Dhuri (**hereinafter to be referred as “trial Court”**), dismissing the suit for declaration with consequential relief of permanent injunction, filed at the instance of respondent Nos. 1 to 3-plaintiffs, was allowed, thereby setting aside the judgment and decree passed by the trial Court.

[2] Notice of the main appeal stood issued vide order dated 14.10.2010 passed by this Court, which stands admitted on 16.08.2011.

[3] Today, an application bearing **CM No. 5240-C of 2025** has been moved on behalf of the applicants-appellants/defendant Nos. 1 to 3, seeking preponement and withdrawal of the main appeal in view of the compromise dated 07.01.2025 (Annexure A-1) having been arrived at between the parties.

[4] In view of the aforesaid development and contents of the application bearing **CM No. 5240-C of 2025**, the same is **allowed**; the main appeal is taken on board today itself; and the same is ordered to be **dismissed as withdrawn**.
