The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the judgment dated 19.02.2025, Annexure P-1, passed by the Education Tribunal, Sonipat, presided over by the District & Sessions Judge in Civil Appeal No.113 of 2021.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner worked in the second respondent School as Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Fine Arts upto June, 2020, whereas the Tribunal in impugned judgment held him entitled to wages/remuneration only upto 15.02.2020, which is contrary to the record as well as the prayer made in the appeal, Annexure P-2, seeking payment of salary from January to June, 2020.

3. A perusal of the impugned judgment shows that on the basis of evidence brought on record, the Tribunal came to conclusion that the petitioner worked in the School till 15.02.2020 and remained absent thereafter.



Accordingly, he was held entitled to remuneration only upto the date he worked in the School. Learned counsel has not been able to refer to any evidence on record establishing that the petitioner worked there after 15.02.2025. Therefore, no exception can be taken to the impugned judgment.

4. In view thereof, petition stands dismissed.
