JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to release Ex-gratia amount as payable to regular employees of the Bank.

2. The petitioner, on 14.11.2013, joined as Clerk in the office of NABARD. She was sent on deputation to HARCO Bank. The petitioner is not paid equivalent to regular employee of HARCO Bank. The respondent No.3- HARCO Bank is paying Ex-gratia amount to its regular employees, however, petitioner is discriminated on the ground that she is on deputation.

3. Mr. K.D.S. Hooda, Advocate for the petitioner submits that representation of the petitioner has been accepted by the Board of Director as well as Chief Minister, however, Managing Director is seized of the matter.



4. Without commenting upon merit of the case and keeping in view limited prayer, the present petition, without seeking response of respondents, stands disposed of with a direction to Managing Director to decide fate of the petitioner within three months from today.
