1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents No.3 to 5 to release their salary with interest from January' 2024 to 18 April' 2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had served representation dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.4 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. At this stage, they will be satisfied in case the aforesaid representation dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) is considered and decided by respondent No.5 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. AG, Haryana who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and



waives service.

5. On request of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
6. Learned State counsel submits that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
7. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merit of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5/competent authority to consider and decide the representation dated 30.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of two months from today.
