1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to official respondents to conduct fair and impartial enquiry in a case arising out of F.I.R No.47, dated 07.05.2025, under Sections 329(3),62,324(4), Police Station PAU, Ludhiana. A further prayer has been made with a prayer to issue direction to respondent No.3 to submit a investigation report in connection with the representation (Annexure P-16) submitted by the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 16.06.2025 (Annexure P-16) to the Commissioner of Police, The Police Commissionerate Office, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana-respondent- No.2 and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take

appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2- The Commissioner of Police, The Police Commissionerate Office, Mini Secretariat, Ludhiana, Punjab to look into representation dated 16.06.2025 (Annexure P-16) and take appropriate action within two weeks, in accordance with law.
