1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.60 dated 19.07.2024 registered under Section 306 of IPC, at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 13.08.2024, this Court has noticed the following contentions:-

“Learned counsel for petitioners stated that deceased victim Rajinder Singh was earlier having dispute with his parental family regarding which FIR No.69 dated 27.08.2019 was registered against father and other family members which is Annexure P-2. In said FIR matter was ultimately compromised as per panchayati compromise dated 02.02.2021 which is Annexure P-3. After the said dispute deceased Rajinder Singh started residing separately along with his wife at village Narangwal,

Tehsil and District Ludhiana. There was no dispute with present petitioners. They are ready to join the investigation.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation on 24.08.2024.
4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 13.08.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
