At this stage, counsel for the petitioner submits that while issuing notice of motion on 13.08.2024, this Court had directed that operation of the impugned order dated 18.04.2024, passed by respondent No. 5, shall remain stayed. He has requested that interim protection may be continued for a reasonable period in order to avail the remedy.

- 5. It is directed that interim order dated 13.08.2024 shall remain in operation for a period of four weeks from today in order to enable the petitioner to take recourse in accordance with law.
