JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to grant compensation of Rs.4 Crore as he has met with an accident while on duty.

2. The petitioner claims that his upper limbs and one lower limb had been amputated on 29.05.2023 due to electric shock. He, at the time of accident, was on duty, thus, he is entitled to compensation payable under Employees Compensation Act, 1923 (hereinafter referred to as '1923 Act').

3. On being confronted with provisions of 1923 Act, the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw with liberty to approach

Commissioner under 1923 Act.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
