1. Prayer made is for directing respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment to the post of ETT against the seats reserved for SC (R & O) Category.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner who applied in the aforesaid category, had secured 57 marks, however, an addition of 5 marks for Graduation, total comes to 62, and participated in scrutiny as well, however, was not appointed only on account of having submitted provisional certificate issued by the University, which he had produced on account of final degree could not be furnished as it was issued later on. He submits that the case of the petitioner is covered by the judgment passed in **Haryana Staff Selection Commission vs. Priyanka and others**, 2021 (4) S.C.T. 80. Regarding the claim raised in this petition, a representation dated 17.09.2024, Annexure P-10, has been submitted,

which has yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same, taking note of the aforesaid judgment, in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 17.09.2024, within a period of 2 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
