1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to constitute SIT to conduct fair and impartial investigation in criminal case having FIR No.77 dated 21.06.2025 registered under Sections 115(2), 351(2), 126(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 (109, 117(2) of BNS,2023 added later on) at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) by considering representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the medico legal report, the injuries on the injured are on left Ulna, which are caused with blunt weapon and Section 109 BNS is added without any



ingredients of Section 109 of BNS. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 i.e. The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide or take necessary action on the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner raising his grievances which has not been considered and no action has been taken till now.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner will be looked into and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law, at the earliest.
- 5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 25.06.2025 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner in accordance with law.
