By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest to the petitioner @ 15% p.a. or more, on the entire amount deposited by the petitioners towards the cost of the plot as the physical possession of the same has not been delivered to the petitioners till date.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already made representations dated 18.06.2025 and 19.06.2025



(Annexures P-2 and P-3) to respondents No. 2 to 3 i.e. Chief Administrator, Administrator and Estate Officer-II, Haryana Shaheri Vikas Pradhikaran, for redressal of their grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the respondent authorities are directed to deal with their concerns/grievances and pass appropriate order on the said representation(s).

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 -HSVP and submits that the said representation/application shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Administrator, Haryana Shaheri Vikas Pradhikaran to look into the pending representation dated 19.06.2025 (Annexures P-3) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
