1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent not to conduct departmental inquiry during pendency of criminal proceedings in FIR No.97 dated 23.05.2024, P.S. CPS Jaipur.

2. Mr. B.S. Rana, Sr. Advocate, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per his instructions till date challan has not been presented. He further submits that respondents may be directed not to proceed with departmental proceedings till the filing of police report.

3. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana expressed ignorance about aforesaid fact. He concedes that this Court in similar cases has directed to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the filing of police report.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid arrangement.
