Main case:

1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and grant promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendent with retrospective effect from the date when his junior was promoted vide order dated 05.10.2023 alongwith all consequential benefits including pay fixation, release of arrears, restoration of seniority in the promoted cadre and continuity of service.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioner(s) has



already served a legal notice dated 23.06.2025 (Annexure P-19) but no action has been thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner(s) would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.5-Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram is directed to consider and decide the said legal notice, in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.5-Commissioner, Gurugram Division, Gurugram to consider and decide the legal notice dated 23.06.2025 (Annexure P-19) and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law expeditiously and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
