SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is Second Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondent No. 4 to 10 from harassing or interfering in the peaceful married life of the petitioners.

In compliance with the order dated 22.07.2025, an affidavit of Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed, which is taken on record.

The relevant paras 13 & 14 of the said affidavit read as under:-

“That it has further been reported by SSP, Amritsar (Rural) that aforesaid order dated 02.07.2025 was received in District Police Office, Amritsar (Rural), which was marked to SHO, Police Station, Lopoke for meticulous compliance. However, Inspector Himanshu

Bhagat 34/CP, Amritsar, SHO, PS, Lopoke further marked the said order to Lady SI Harman Kaur No. 3607/PBI, Incharge, Police Post, Kakkar. The process adopted by Inspector Himanshu Bhagat was contrary to the provisions of SOP dated 23.01.2025 issued by Department of Home Affairs, Punjab which mandates that said order should have been marked to the nominated police official/ ASI Major Singh, PS, Lopoke for necessary action. In view of the aforesaid negligence in discharge of official duties, Regular Departmental Enquiry has been initiated against Inspector Himanshu Bhagat 34/CP, Amritsar, SHO, PS, Lopoke vide order No. 3811- 15/Steno dated 19.07.2025 issued by SSP, Amritsar (Rural). Similarly, Regular Departmental Enquiry has been initiated against SI Harman Kaur No. 3607/PBI for negligence in discharge of official duties as the said official made no effort to intimate the nominated police official/ ASI Major Singh for consideration of the matter within 03 days. Therefore, Regular Departmental Enquiry has been ordered to be conducted against SI Harman Kaur No. 3607/PBI vide order No. 3816-20/Steno dated 19.07.2025 issued by SSP, Amritsar (Rural).

14. That on the basis of reports received from the field units, the deponent craves kind indulgence to assure this Hon'ble Court that timely action is taken by the field units upon receipt of information regarding run-away couple.

Faced with the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioners has no further contentions to advance and expresses satisfaction, tendering no objection to the disposal of the petition.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of, as no further intervention by this Court is deemed necessary.
