SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This petition essentially assails the notification dated 01.06.2023 (Annexure P-23), by which the State of Haryana laid down procedure for admission to different courses in the field of Nursing, Physiotherapy and Paramedical for academic session 2023-24.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners, who is representing one of the Institutions imparting the course of Physiotherapy, is that as per the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, and the Haryana Private Health Sciences Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Fee and Maintenance of Educational Standards) Act, 2012, admission to any professional or technical course ought to be through a common entrance test. However, the State is permitting respondents No.6 to 17 – Universities to admit students in the said professional/technical course of Physiotherapy, on the basis of 12th Class examination marks and not through common entrance test.

3. The academic session 2023-24 is over and, therefore, the exercise of adjudication of this petition is now academic.

3.1 However, it is open to the petitioners to re-visit the Court in case any unlawful means for admission, which is contrary to law, is adopted by the State.



- 4. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
- 5. All the pending applications also stand disposed of.
