1. In the present bunch of petitions, the detail of which is mentioned in the heading, claim of the petitioner(s) is that the petitioner(s) were not being allowed to appear in the Haryana State Teachers Eligibility Test on the ground that the petitioner(s) did not had the required qualification for the post. By an interim order of this Court dated 28.12.2020, the petitioner(s) were allowed to appear provisionally.

2. The petitioner in CWP-22728-2020, namely, Rahul though appeared but could not clear the said test, hence, the issue raised in the present petition has been rendered academic and the same is disposed of with the observation that no further orders are required to be passed.

3. With regard to CWP-22802-2020, Rahul Singh, learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has already joined another Institution and is working there. That being the factual position, it can be safely presumed that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present remedy, especially when, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to press the present petition.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.



5. In the other two writ petitions i.e. CWP-22791-2020 and CWP-22792-2020 also, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner(s) to press the present petitions. As the Roll Numbers of these two students have not been given, the respondents are not in a position to check, whether they have appeared in the examination under the interim order of the Court or they have cleared the test or not.

6. Keeping in view the fact that the present petitions are not being pressed as no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioner(s), CWP-22791-2020 and CWP-22792-2020 are also dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to revive in case the petitioner(s) therein have cleared the examination in their provisional participation so as to decide the issue on merits.

7. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
