



petitioner is nowhere named in the FIR and came to be nominated subsequently. It has been submitted that the petitioner otherwise has a clean record.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Mahender Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 14.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.
4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned State Counsel, the order dated 14.08.2024, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
5. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
6. Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed to be an expression of opinion by this Court lest it may prejudice the trial. The learned trial Court is directed to proceed with the trial on its own merits, strictly in accordance with law.
