By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allot an alternative plot i.e. 888P, in Sector-46, Faridabad, as the originally allotted plot to the petitioners is disputed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 05.02.2025 (Annexures P-3) to the respondents, for redressal of their grievances, but no action has been taken thereon till date. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, if



the respondent authorities are directed to deal with their concerns/grievances and pass an appropriate order on the said legal notice.

3. Served with the advance copy of the petition, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4 -HSVP and submits that the said representation/legal notice shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

4. Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Estate Officer, Haryana Shaheri Vikas Pradhikaran, Faridabad to look into the legal notice dated 05.02.2025 (Annexure P-3) and pass an appropriate reasoned order thereon, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of copy/production of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
