N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.45 dated 22.04.2025 registered under Sections 318(3)/336(2)/336(3)/340(2), 61(2) and Section13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the only role attributed to the petitioner was that he had introduced the complainant with Gurjinder Singh, who was working as a travel agent. Even no payment was made to the petitioner in the present case. By referring to the compromise (Annexure P-3), learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, while Mr. Parminder Singh, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and submitted that he has no objection if the present petition is accepted.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the case file.

6. Since the only allegation against the petitioner is that he had introduced the complainant with Gurjinder Singh, who was working as a travel agent as also the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise (Annexure P-3) and a quashing petition has been preferred before this Court on the basis of a compromise, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as provided 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. It will be open for the investigating officer to call the petitioner to join the investigation, if so required, by issuing a written notice in this regard and he shall abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.
