1. None has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.
2. The same was the position on the last date of hearing as well.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 submitted that the present petition has been filed seeking directions for setting aside the impugned order dated 30.08.2019 whereby the application filed under Section 319 of Cr.P.C. for summoning of respondent No.2 as an additional accused was dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur, but during the pendency of the present petition, the main accused has already been acquitted. He submitted that the allegations in the present case were pertaining to having illicit relationship but since the main accused



has been acquitted nothing would survive for adjudication in the present petition.

4. Since learned counsel for the petitioner has not appeared today, as well as on the last date of hearing, it appears that he is no longer interested in pursuing the present petition.
