1. The prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 29.05.2015 as also for directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits and provisional pension.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the similar situated employees had filed CWP-24736-2017 titled as **Prem Chand Dhand vs. State of Punjab and Another** and **Gurcharan Singh Hunjan vs. State of Punjab and Others**, CWP-20364-2016, which were allowed by this Court on 01.12.2018 and 01.03.2019 respectively and prays that his case be considered, keeping in view the aforesaid judgments.

3. The aforesaid facts having been brought out, during the course of hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the respondents would not be averse to having a relook at the matter and decided afresh, taking note of the afore-referred judgments, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable

manner.

- 4. The aforesaid satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 5. The matter stands disposed of accordingly and if the petitioner is found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same may be passed after granting opportunity of hearing to her and shall contain reasons, whereupon she shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
