Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Amrinder Singh, IPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, is taken on record.

It has been alleged in the reply that in the complaint/representation dated 28.06.2025 (Annexure P3) an inquiry was conducted and it was observed that in case FIR No.309 dated 26.12.2024, under Sections 103(1), 61(2), 111(2)(3)(4)(5), 190, 191(3), 238 and 324(5) of BNS, registered at Police Station Radaur (Yamuna Nagar), accused Munish and Tarun Singari were arrested by STF Unit Ambala and they disclosed

that in the month of September, 2024, they gave Rs.2,00,000/- to Paramjit Singh (husband of the petitioner), father of Sunny Salempur (son of petitioner), on the ground that Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) had helped the members of his gang and accused Pankaj Malik, Arjun Unhedi, Virender Golni, who had murdered liquor dealers. On the basis of which SI Naresh Kumar of STF Unit Karnal, along with his team went to the house of Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) on 14.04.2025, where Paramjit Singh and his nephew Sukhdev Singh were found present and a notice under Section 35 of BNS was given to Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) to join the investigation. Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) and his nephew Sukhdev Singh received the notice and signed it. After giving the notice SI Naresh Kumar along with his team, went to his legitimate posting. On 15.04.2025, Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) was produced before the STF Unit Karnal by his nephew Sukhdev Singh. SI Naresh Kumar interrogated Paramjit Singh (husband of petitioner) and on finding the evidence fit for arrest, he was arrested as per rules in the afore said case. After that SI Naresh Kumar never visited the house of the petitioner. As per inquiry it was observed that neither the complainant nor any of her family members were ever harassed or kept unnecessarily in detention without any reason as alleged and the complaint/ representation Annexure P3 had been given with intention of influencing the investigation in the aforesaid FIR.

In para No.3 of the status report, case detail of 17 criminal cases registered against Barjinder Singh @ Sunny (son of the petitioner) has been given. It has also been alleged in the status report that the petitioner has no threat perception at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and the present petition has been filed just to create pressure in the aforesaid FIR

registered against Pramjit Singh (husband of the petitioner).

In para No.10 of the status report, it has been specifically mentioned that the petitioner does not require any protection as she had never been harassed in any manner by the police.

So, keeping in view of the aforesaid status report, no further order is required to be passed and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
