“There is an appeal by the Insurance Company on the issue of liability for claiming recoveries. This adjudication does not require the presence of the claimants. The appeal against the claimant is dismissed.”

The learned counsel representing the appellant submits that with regard to the validity of the driving licence, the issue is now covered against the Insurance Company in view of the judgment passed in **Mukund Dewangan vs. Oriental Insurance Company Limited, 2017(4) R.C.R.(Civil) 111**
