1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners, who are living in live-in relationship.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners are major and are living in live-in relationship against the wishes of private respondents. It is further submitted that petitioner No.1 is married with respondent No.4 and blessed with a male child. However, as respondent No.4 was alcoholic and used to beat petitioner No.1, she started to live with petitioner No.2, who is unmarried. He submits that the petitioners apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 09.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) to respondent no.2 for granting protection to their life and liberty.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a

direction to respondent no.2- Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of their live-in relationship.
