By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioners seek quashing of FIR (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR are as follows:

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise/affidavit dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the



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parties. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, vide report dated 21.02.2025 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Mr. Naresh Paul, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 admits the factum of compromise having been effected between the parties. A copy of Receipt of costs of Rs. 60,000/- has been placed on record in compliance of the order dated 03.02.2025.

4. In view of the report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending, since respondent No.2 has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 04 dated 02.01.2024 under Sections 406, 420, 108, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Sector-8, Faridabad and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
