1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 for registration of an FIR at Police Station Talwandi Choudharian, District Kapurthala with regard to murder of one Chamak Singh.

2. Short reply has been filed by the respondent-State. It is submitted therein and learned State counsel has argued that after conducting thorough inquiry in the matter, it was found that Chamak Singh had neither been poisoned nor was murdered in any other way. Rather, it had surfaced, on the basis of the post-mortem report as well as FSL report, that he had committed suicide.

3. Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petition may be disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

4. Disposed of with the liberty as prayed for.
