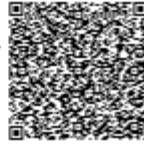

SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present writ petition, petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to carry out corrections in the column of spouse in the Death Certificate, Annexure P-6, of Shekhar Bhalla, i.e. petitioner's husband and name of petitioner be incorporated.

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2. Upon notice, a short response has been filed on behalf of respondent No.3, wherein it has been submitted that petitioner had applied for correction through a physical application, Annexure P-7, which cannot be entertained. Mr. Aggarwal has made a reference to the stand taken in the reply to submit that the petitioner has been asked to apply online through the e-sewa kendra. He has made a reference to letter dated 29.05.2024, Annexure R-3/1, addressed to the petitioner.

3. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner states that he will comply with procedural formalities and submit an application through the online mode. In case, petitioner does so, it is expected that the respondents, who will take necessary action as expeditiously as possible preferably within two months from the date of submission of online application.

4. Writ petition is disposed of.
