1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.17 dated 24.03.2024 registered under Sections 406 & 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station NRI, District SAS Nagar.

2. On receipt of advance copy of the petition, Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents-State and on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh, submits that there are total three accused namely Puru Nand Kumar; Nand Kumar Alani and Deepak Kumar in the present case. Accused No.1 & 2 are already on bail and challan against them has already been filed before the Trial Court on 16.06.2025. With regard to accused No.3-Deepak Kumar, learned State counsel submits that he is absconding

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and has gone abroad and look out notice has already been issued and the police is in process of initiating proceedings under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. against him.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above development in the case, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
