1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 21.06.2025, under Sections 21, 27-B,29/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga.
2. Vide order dated 14.07.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 14.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) B.N.S.S.
