1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.160 dated 20.06.2025, registered under Sections 191(2), 190, 329 (4) of BNS 2023 (Sections 351(2), 318(4), 61(2) added later on), at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani, Haryana.

2. Vide order dated 16.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioner has joined investigation on 28.07.2025. Learned State counsel submits that he has not been cooperating with the Investigating Agency. Since the names of other persons involved in the occurrence have been disclosed, his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. Keeping in view of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present



petition is allowed and the order dated 16.07.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (analogous to Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure).
