1. In the present petition, challenge is to the letter dated 07.07.2025 (Annexure P/10), whereby the members of the petitioner-school have been directed to admit students without following the statutory limits.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-Schools Association concedes the factum that there exists liability upon the member of the petitioner-Schools Association to admit 25% of the total strength of the schools from the children recommended by the Government of Haryana under the Right to Education Act, 2009 (hereinafter referred to as '2009 Act') and the liabilities which have been fastened upon the petitioner-Schools Association under the 2009 Act, will be complied with by the members of the petitioner-Schools Association without there being any resistance.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner-Schools Association further submits that the children recommended by the State of Haryana under the 25% quota, under the 2009 Act, will be given admission within a period of 02 days without there being any further delay on the part of the members of the petitioner-Schools Association.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner-Schools Association submits that though, they have granted the admission to the children under 25% quota under the 2009 Act but the reimbursement qua the expenditure on such students is not being done by the State, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner-Schools Association.

5. Notice of motion qua said aspect only.

6. Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, any member of the petitioner-Schools Association files any representation raising the said grievance within a period of 02 days from today, the same will be considered on merits and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of such representation and in case, it is found that any liability of the State exists, the said liability will be released by the State within a period of 08 weeks from the date of passing of such order otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the concerned member of petitioner-Schools Association will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the concerned member of the petitioner-Schools Association for its information and necessary action.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner-Schools Association submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the

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respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

8. Ordered accordingly.
