The petitioner has challenged the notice dated 10.07.2025 whereby the respondents were to carry out the demolition drive in the Wool Market, Sector 38, Chandigarh.

2. Issue notice to the respondents.
3. Mr. Sanjeev Ghai, Addl. Standing Counsel and Ms. Arushi Dubey, Junior Panel Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has filed an affidavit of Mr. Rajiv Tewari, Assistant Estate Officer-III wherein it has been stated that the demolition drive to remove the encroachment in the wool market, Sector 38-C, Chandigarh on 14.07.2025 has been postponed. The next demolition drive of the said site will be conveyed to the petitioner as and when the date is fixed.

4. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be given liberty to pursue his representation dated 10.07.2025 (Annexure P-6)
5. In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner appears to have been substantially redressed. The petition stands disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
