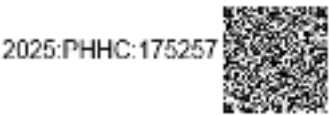

1. Today, lawyers are abstaining from work.
2. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for quashing of FIR No.242 dated 22.08.2024 registered at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, District Rohtak (Annexure P-1) under Sections 109(1), 115, 118(1), 126(2), 3(5), 324(6), 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
3. Reply by way of an affidavit dated 02.12.2025 of Gulab Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rohtak filed in the Registry on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
4. This Court vide order dated 19.08.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send



his/her report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

5. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Rohtak and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 22.09.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

6. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served by continuing with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant F.I.R. following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 titled as '*Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another*' and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in (2012) 10 SCC 303 titled as '*Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others*'. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the FIR No.242 dated 22.08.2024 registered at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, District Rohtak (Annexure P-1) under Sections 109(1), 115, 118(1), 126(2), 3(5), 324(6), 351(3) of BNS, 2023 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.
