1. The petitioner in the instant (second) petition is seeking the concession of interim bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for a period of 40 days on medical grounds, in case FIR No.74 dated 23.03.2023 under Sections 21, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') registered at Police Station STF, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

2. Status report by way of supplementary affidavit of Harpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Anti-Narcotics Task Force, Ludhiana Range, Ludhiana, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

3. Learned counsel, on instructions, has submitted that the petitioner during the pendency of the instant petition and after he was extended the concession of interim bail on medical grounds, has fled away to Dubai. A prayer has, therefore, been made for dismissal of the
