Main case

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3
to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of
respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has placed on record copy of Rapat
No.15 dated 18.07.2025, under Sections 170, 126 of BNSS registered at
Police Station Derabassi, against respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners had moved a representation dated 10.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) before respondent No.2 and he would be satisfied if respondents No.2 is directed to look into the same, regarding threat perception.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that she has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 10.07.2025 (Annexure P-3) is looked into, regarding threat perception of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), to look into the aforesaid representation, regarding threat perception of the petitioner and to take appropriate action as per law, if any required, at the earliest.
