SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.48 dated 10.05.2025 under Section 118(1) of BNS 2023 (Section 117(2) added lateron), Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Batala.

2. Vide order dated 17.07.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 17.07.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

4. In view of above mentioned contention, on the instructions of ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, who is present in the



Court, the learned State Counsel has stated that in compliance with the order dated 17.07.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of the present case.

5. In view of the above mentioned submission of learned State counsel, the order dated 17.07.2025, whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
