1. The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.23 dated 10.03.2025, under Sections 21/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur, Punjab.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 17.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required in this case.
3. Learned State counsel has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and, on instructions from ASI Resham Singh, further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 17.07.2025 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
