The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to the respondents to take appropriate legal action on complaints dated 21.05.2024, 06.05.2024 and 09.05.2024 (Annexures P-1 to P-3, respectively).

The learned State counsel has filed reply dated 27.11.2024 by way of affidavit on behalf of the official respondents-State in the Court today and the same is taken on record. He refers to the status report and submits that the petitioners have effected a compromise with the private respondents and the statement was recorded on 17.11.2024 in which they have categorically submitted that they do not want to pursue the complaints (Annexures P-1 to P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition in view of the statement suffered by the petitioners on 17.11.2024 before the jurisdictional police authorities. However, he seeks liberty to file fresh petition in case the factual position as projected in the status report is incorrect.
