The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents no. 2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent no.4.

Learned State counsel submits that a speaking order dated 23.07.2025 has been passed on the representation submitted by the petitioners. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners. The relevant part of the order read as under:-

“The above noted petition had been filed of petitioners in the Honorable High Court of Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh for protection of their life and liberty. In compliance of the order of Honorable High Court the directions were issued to SI Banarsi Dass to Protection the life and liberty of the petitioners of PS City Gurdaspur. SI Banarsi Dass got recorded the statement of petitioner

no. 02 Ravinder Singh in which he stated that they do not require any Police protection as they came to compromise with their family. They have been directed to approach the concerned police station in case they need any security from the private respondent. The Direction issued by the honorable High Court have been duly complied with. ”

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy by way of appeal as per notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).
