SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to release the final bill payment in terms of Annexure P2 dated 22.01.2025 and Annexure P4 dated 07.06.2025 along with interest.

2. Mr. Deepanshu Mehta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and has filed vakalatnama on their



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behalf, which is taken on record.

3. In deference to the previous order passed by this Court, counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 has placed on record copy of speaking order bearing No.SAS Div./2025/4260 dated 29.08.2025. He submits that a final bill was prepared in presence of petitioner and an amount of Rs.86.59 lakhs has been found due, which shall be paid after adopting due procedure stipulated by the Punjab Health Systems Corporation. Upon categorical instructions from Sh. Ishant Goyal, Executive Engineer (Civil), Punjab Health Systems Corporation, SAS Nagar, counsel states that the said amount would be disbursed to the petitioner within a period of four months.

4. Counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the statement made by counsel for respondents No.2 and 3.

5. In view of the above development, writ petition is disposed of.
