1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 483 of BNSS with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.239 dated 16.09.2021, registered under Sections 420, 34 and 120-B of IPC and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations were primarily levelled against Sachin Kumar son of Vinay Kumar and Pooja Yadav. In fact Sachin Kumar has already been granted the concession of bail by the Court of Sessions Judge, Rewari on 04.06.2022. Even others similarly placed co-accused Pooja Yadav and Sachin @ Sachin Yadav have also been granted the concession of bail. The petitioner was arrested in the present case



on 24.02.2025 and is in custody for the last about 05 months. Further, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

5. In the present case, it is not in dispute that other similarly placed co-accused Sachin Kumar son of Vinay Kumar, Pooja Yadav and Sachin @ Sachin Yadav have also admitted to concession of bail by the Courts. The petitioner is at par with them. Thus, the further custody of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned.
