SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for intentional disobedience of the order dated 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-7412-2025 titled *Shiv Kumar Vs. State of Punjab & others*.

2. Relevant portion of the order dated 19.03.2025 passed in CWP-7412-2025 is reproduced as under:

“On the asking of the Court, Mr.T.P.S.Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, legal notice dated 09.01.2025, Annexure P-4, has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks and otherwise due reason for not accepting the claim will be mentioned for the information and necessary action.”

3. Learned Counsel for the State contends that in compliance of the same, speaking order dated 19.08.2025 is passed. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner. Copy of the same has been supplied to Learned counsel for the petitioner and also placed on record.

4. In view of the above, contempt is purged and rule is discharged. Needless to say that if the petitioner is aggrieved by the said order, he can challenge the same in accordance with law.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
