This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction to respondent no. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of Respondent No 4 to 7 as the petitioner is receiving continues threats of his being involvement n false criminal case and of being eliminated if the petitioner has not given them possession of his ancestral agricultural land, from respondent no. 4 to 7.

On 18.07.2025, instructions were called for and in response thereto today, reply by way of affidavit of Sundeep Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (H), District Moga has been filed by learned State Counsel, the same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to the counsel opposite. As per affidavit filed, the petitioner has joined the enquiry, however at the initial stage of the enquiry, the present petitioner has suffered his statement that he has filed a

civil suit regarding the suit land which is pending before the Civil Judge, Baghapurana and the decision of the Civil Court would be binding upon the parties, therefore, he does not want to pursue his complaint and if the complaint is consigned, he would have no objection.

Further, a statement to that effect dated 26.07.2024 which is part of the police file duly signed by the petitioner has been produced by learned State Counsel, though in Punjabi language, the same is taken on record as document 'A'. This Court having fully knowledge of the Punjabi language has gone through the same according to which it can be translated as under :-

'Statement in respect of Amar Singh Gill s/o Bachittar Singh Gill s/o Inder Singh aged about 75 years, resident of Village Phullewala, Tehsil Bhagapurana, District Moga, Mobile no. 7508631329.

It is stated that I am a resident of abovementioned address and do the work of cultivation. I have come present in the office of your goodself with regard to complaint number 291 P.C.2C/25 dated 30-06-25 made by me against Nirmal Singh s/o Mukhtiar Singh, resident of Village Manuke, District Moga and state that I have filed a case in the learned Court at Bhagapurana with regard to dispute of land which is under consideration in Ld. Court Bhagapurana. Whatever decision will be passed by the Ld. Court will be acceptable by me. Therefore, now, I don't want to get initiated any proceeding in my complaint. I have no objection if instant complaint is filed. I have got typed this statement without any coercion and with my consent, read and heard the same which is correct.'

In light of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
