1. Mr. Saurav Bhatia, Advocate appears on behalf of petitioner and files Power of attorney, which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 20.07.2022 (Annexure P-11) but, neither the reply is being filed to the writ petition nor the said legal notice is being decided which is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, that the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Learned State counsel submits that in case, the legal notice dated 20.07.2022 (Annexure P-11), has been received in the office of the

concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

- 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
- 5. Ordered accordingly.
- 6. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
