1. The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to expeditiously consider and decide the legal notice dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and to release the due salary along with consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a legal notice dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) was sent to respondents for redressal of grievances of the petitioner, but no action has been taken by the respondents on the said legal notice and she shall be satisfied in case, appropriate directions are issued to the respondents to examine the legal notice and to pass an order in a time bound manner.
3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record carefully.
4. At this stage, I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the

petitioner is to be genuine. Consequently, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking and well reasoned order.

5. Needless to observe that, in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed in the legal notice dated 13.05.2025 (Annexure P-4), consequential benefits may also be released to the petitioner, without any further delay.
