1. The trial court in a summary suit for recovery of the amount has granted conditional leave to defend to the defendant.
2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner (defendant herein) submits that once the petitioner's defence was found triable, then no condition could be imposed.
3. It is evident that the court has only directed the petitioner to furnish his surety bond in the sum of Rs.2,50,000/-, which is not onerous.
4. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
5. Dismissed.
